It was then enacted by the Minister Churchwardens and
 the parishioners then present that whereas the sum layd
 on by three former vestrys amounting to 31 s^{rs} are not
 found sufficient for y^e publick uses of y^e Parish It is now
 enacted that y^e sum of three pound. s^{rs} be appoynted
 upon e^{ch} soule of the Inhabitants of y^e Parish Indivually
 and to be accomted for at Exor Next, over and above the
 former 31^l s^{rs}, that y^e 34^l s^{rs} in all and y^e the same Land
 of Edonderry shall pay the affoyrd s^{rs} by the decess and the same
