 & to Mr Mathers for singlers — — — 04-0  
 Total 1-03 = 0

At a vestry holden in St. Pauls Church of Sego on  
 the Monday of 10<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1699

It was there enacted by the Minister and Parishioners  
 that they should of sum of Lorn pound, sh<sup>d</sup> be levied of the Inha-  
 bitants of St Pauls parish for making two new windows a pulpit &  
 Cloath and other necessaries And y<sup>e</sup> Edward Stevenson and  
 John Binks shall be Churchwardens for y<sup>e</sup> next year & y<sup>e</sup> John  
 Robson shall be surveyor of y<sup>e</sup> highways from Kilvargin River  
 to Don derry William Dixon & Robert Black to stand survey  
 from Knock Bridge to Sylow & from Robert Black to Sylow  
 John Farthle to stand surveyor from Portadown Bridge to Portoma  
 & from John Binks to Sego & from y<sup>e</sup> Kings Road  
 through Don derry to Sego. Mr John Mathers from St Dunstons  
 hill to Hillside main & from y<sup>e</sup> Blaw stone to S Low mill and  
 George Thomson from Hillvargin River to y<sup>e</sup> long plaine  
 James Crooks for y<sup>e</sup> Maynlagh.
