25th Day of Aprile 1700

It was then enacted by y^e Ministers Churchwardens and

sa^{id} parish which together wth the sum of fifteen pound now in bank
compleatly twenty nine pound & ten shillings & ordered for the
Use following (viz) eight pound to Mr John Mathers for which
together with the owⁿ shingles now on y^e Church he is to find new
shingles for covering y^e Church also four pound to John Mores and
John in Comony for shingling y^e Church & three pound for nails
& other materials. & for two new seats & enlarging the owⁿ Comon
seats and for maintaining the y^e Child or disposing of it if the
Churchwardens shall think fitt, for providing of Elements for the
Sacrament of y^e E^l Supper for making of a new gate & erecting
a stile & other publick expences & y^e sum of twenty pound more
be levied of y^e parish by y^e present Churchwardens within a month
of Easter next for a bell & bellfrow and now allowed by the parish
in l^{ie} of fifteen pound formerly ordered for y^e Use and at y^e present
applyed to more necessary Uses.
