of April 1701

It was then granted by the Minister Churchwardens & parishioners

one pound 6^d; for Bads for y^e poor one pound 6^d; William Corner
of Moinloghs, and Ralph Willson of Lavaghery, to be Churchwardens
in stead of Robert Thomson & Thomas Gilpin John Gibson son
to be surveyor in stead of Anthony Molcalf, Richard Smurphat
in stead of M^r John Mathers, Richard in Mary in stead of Thomas
Hamphrey, M^r Francis Mathers in stead of John Tardale, George
Thomson to stand, Robert Black of Briagh in stead of William Roney,
Robert Black son to stand
