be allotted upon the parishioners and landholders of
the said parish to be paid for the use following viz
for casting of Bell at 2 per pound $4-16-4$ ^{ll}
for 17 pound over weight at 12 per pound $0-17-0$ ^{ll}
for altering of iron work $00-4-0$ ^{ll}
for stock and stocking the Bell $01-06-00$ ^{ll}
for walt of Bell metal $4-04-00$ ^{ll}

hundred quarters pounds
The new Bell weighs 2 : 2 : 9
The old Bell weighed — 2 : 1 : 20
