The Secretary was requested to inform Mr. Reid Contractor for Schoolmaster's new house that the fine, under the contract, would be enforced if the work be not at once completed.

Mr. Wilson Irwin kindly undertook to receive subscriptions to the Chair fund for current year.

A meeting of the Select Vestry was held on 7 Dec 1901 - Present The Very Rev'd The Dean of Dromore - in the Chair - Rev'd W. T. Grey, Curate, Joseph Murray Thos. Stothers, Jas Collins, Thos. Martin, Wilson Irwin Jas Albin, Thos. Montgomery, Geo Calvert, H. J. M. Dowdell & H. R. Atkinson

It was proposed by Mr. Stothers & seconded by Mr. Murray that Mr. Atkinson be requested to try to arrange Mr. Walby's accts, for planes &c & surveying done in connexion with Schoolmaster's house, for £10 or less, if possible.

Details connected with Mr. Reid's contract for Schoolmaster's house not having been completed the Dean undertook to see Reid on the matter and if necessary write to Dublin about it.

It was agreed to pay the Sexton £1 for expense incurred in washing & cleaning the Church in a thorough manner.

Injurious omisances having been committed on School grounds & property it was proposed by Geo Calvert and seconded by John Montgomery & passed, that the next offender be summoned & punished according to law.

It was proposed by Mr Stothers and seconded by Mr Calvert that a letter of condolence in the name of the Select Vestry, be sent to Mr Abraham Macomur, on the death of her late husband, who was a respected Member of the Vestry and a liberal supporter of all Parochial Funds.

A special meeting of the Select Vestry was held on 22 Nov 1901 - Present the Very Rev'd. The Dean of Dromore, in the Chair; John Montgomery, Wilson Lewis, Geo Calvert, Jas Collins, Joseph Murray, Thomas Stothers & W. R. Atkinson.

Mr W. H. Hunter attended to meet the Vestry to consult as to an arrangement being come to between the Vestry and the Rural District Council of Lurgan with the object of handing over the Stable etc to the Council. Mr Nelson Ruddell was also despatched to attend to meet the Vestry, but wrote to say he could not come.

It was proposed by Mr Stothers & seconded by Mr Atkinson that Messrs Geo Calvert and Thomas Gilpin should represent the interests of the Vestry at next meeting of the Rural District Council and treat with them as to terms with the hope the matter might be finally arranged.
