by Mr. Wilson Irwin (passed), Resolved that we
accept Mr. R. Lutton's plans & specifications for
proposed Stable, Cycle house & Carriage Shed at the
estimated cost of about £120; and instruct the
Committee to make arrangements with Mr. R. Lutton
to have the proposed works proceeded with at once.

Atkinson be requested to act as Treasurer to
receive subscriptions for the execution of proposed
works.
